

Thomas Richardson – JVI Session -- Joint Vienna Institute



Thomas Richardson has been Director of the Joint Vienna Institute (JVI) since September 2016. Prior to JVI, he was Senior Resident Representative for the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in India, Nepal and Bhutan from 2012-2016, and before that he was Senior Resident Representative and IMF mission chief in Uganda. During the course of more than 20 years at the Fund, he has served as IMF mission chief for a number of countries, including Cyprus, Belarus, and Moldova, and has worked on extensively in China and Russia, in the latter case as IMF Resident Representative from 1995-98. Before joining the IMF, he was Assistant Professor of Economics at Yale University. His PhD in Economics is from Columbia University (1991).
